Dr. Rashmee Singh is an Assistant Professor of Sociology and Legal Studies at the University of Waterloo. She has published in such journals as the *Canadian Journal of Sociology* and *Theoretical Criminology* and was recently awarded a UW/ SSHRC Seed Grant to conduct research on prostitution courts in Chicago.

Dr. Grégoire Webber is an Associate Professor of Law at Queen's Law. He is a former Trudeau Foundation scholar and clerk to Justice Ian Binnie of the Supreme Court of Canada. Among his various publications is the recent co-edited volume, *Proportionality and the Rule of Law: Rights, Reasoning and Justification*.
